

2023 Border Caravan & Camping Leisurefest

Passport to Freedom Conditions of Entry



1. The promoter is Caravan Trade & Industries Association of Victoria T/A Caravan Industry Victoria, Unit 8/88 Dynon Road, West Melbourne, VIC 3003. (ABN: 67 413 472 774) (the **Promoter**).
2. The competition will run at the following 2023 Caravan Industry Victoria Events:
 - a. **Victoria 25 – 27 August 2023** (Border Caravan & Camping Leisurefest (Wodonga Racecourse - Hamilton Smith Dr, Wodonga 3690);
 - b. **Victoria 5 – 8 October 2023** (Melbourne Caravan & Camping Leisurefest (Sandown Racecourse - 591-659 Princes Hwy, Springvale 3171); and
 - c. **Victoria 17 – 19 November 2023** Bendigo Caravan & Camping Leisurefest (Bendigo Racecourse, Heinz Street, Bendigo Victoria 3550)(the **Events**).
3. Entry is open only to Australian residents who:
 - a. are aged 18 or over;
 - b. attend at least one Event; and
 - c. have a compatible smartphone(**Eligible Entrants**).
4. Directors, officers, management and employees (and their immediate families) of the Promoter and agencies, companies or participating premises associated with this competition are ineligible to participate.
5. The competition commences on Friday 25 August 2023 at 9:30am (AEST) and ends on Sunday 19 November 2023 at 4:00pm (AEDT) (the **Competition Period**).
6. To enter, Eligible Entrants must:
 - a. download and access the Event App, Caravan Industry Victoria, downloadable from:
 - from the App store at apps.apple.com/app/id1563293929
 - from Google Play at play.google.com/store/apps/details?id=au.com.ciavic.civ; and
 - b. then during the Competition Period, attend at least one of the Events and while at the Event:
 - visit all passport stations (locations of these passport stations can be found on the map on the Event App and located around the Event);
 - locate and scan the QR code at each passport station with your smartphone; and
 - fill out and submit the online entry form on the Event App, including by providing contact details and all other requested information to receive an entry into the major prize draw (and to receive an entry into the minor prize draw if you attend, and fill out the entry form at, the Border Caravan & Camping Leisurefest Wodonga Event).

15. The minor prize winners will be notified by phone and email within 5 business days of determination and winners of the EF2000iS Inverter Generator and Skyline Camper Hire will be published on www.caravanshow.com.au (the **Website**) on Tuesday 5 September 2023 for a period of 28 days.
16. There will be 1 major draw conducted. The major draw will be held at the Promoter's Event Office at Bendigo Racecourse, Heinz St, Ascot VIC 3551 on Monday 20 November at 11:00am (AEDT).
17. The first valid entry drawn randomly from all of the entries received during the Competition Period (including all entries associated with each Event) will win the major prize.
18. The Promoter may draw additional reserve entries in the major draw and record them in order, in case a winning entry/entrant is deemed invalid or the prize is unclaimed (**Major Prize Reserve Entrants**).
19. There is 1 major prize available to be won.
20. The major prize is a Crusader Gladiator Force Caravan <https://crusadercaravans.com.au/crv-range/crv-embed-home/range-crv-gladiator-force/> valued at **\$79,290**. The prize does not include comprehensive insurance or any accessories not specified. By entering, you consent to receive email or SMS messages from the Promoter without any functional unsubscribe facility if they relate primarily to the conduct of this competition

 - g. how entrants can access to the personal information the Promoter holds about them and seek correction of the information; and
 - h. how to complain about a privacy breach and how the Promoter will deal with such a complaint.
41. Nothing in these Conditions of Entry restricts, excludes or modifies any consumer rights under any statute including the Competition and Consumer Act 2010 (Cth).
42. Subject to the previous paragraph, the Promoter and the agencies and companies associated with this competition are not liable (including in negligence) for any loss (including indirect, special or consequential loss or loss of profits), expense, damage, personal injury (including allergies, skin conditions or other reactions, as relevant), illness or death suffered in connection with this competition or any prize, except for any liability which under statute cannot be excluded (in which case that liability is limited to the greatest extent allowed by law).
43. Without limiting the previous paragraph, the Promoter and its associated agencies and companies are not liable for any loss of, damage to or delay in delivery of the prize, or for any damage that occurs to displayed prize/s (if relevant). Prizes will only be delivered to addresses in Australia.
44. Participation in this competition implies acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
45. This competition is in no way sponsored, endorsed or administered by, or associated with any social media platform, including Facebook, Instagram and Twitter. Entrants provide their information to the Promoter and not to any social media platform. By entering, entrants completely release any relevant social media platforms from any and all liability.
